Pinhole photography allows you to make a photograph that requires only a lighttight container (box, can,...) with a tiny hole in one side (as a camera) and any photosensitive surface in it.

Pinhole Photography is a great way to learn the theory of photography it is also a great creative tool, each camera has unique properties due to its individual construction. Because of the lens-less construction the images appear softer but have an infinite depth of field (all parts of the image equally in focus)
